Roadmap Options

A snapshot of the 9th through 12th grade roadmap — built around each student's unique goals.

9TH GRADE

Build academic foundation, explore interests, initiate PSAT planning & develop preliminary roadmap

10TH GRADE

Develop student profile, introduce college exploration, refine PSAT strategy & update roadmap

11TH GRADE

Initiate SAT/ACT planning, address skill gaps, finalize strategy & build the student profile

12TH GRADE

Finalize college list, complete essays, manage submissions, review financial aid & decide

CONSULTATION SCHEDULE

Your Journey, Step by Step

1

First Consultation • 10th Grade

Review academic performance, assess interests & strengths, set academic direction, initiate PSAT planning, and develop the preliminary roadmap.

2

Second Consultation • End of 10th Grade 1 Hr

Evaluate progress, discuss summer activities, introduce college major exploration, and refine the PSAT strategy. Provide an updated roadmap.

3

Third Consultation • PSAT Scores 1 Hr

Review PSAT performance, initiate SAT/ACT planning, address skill gaps, begin developing the student profile, and provide an updated roadmap.

4

Fourth Consultation • 11th Grade Mid-Year 1 Hr

Assess academic & test progress, plan the first SAT/ACT attempt, refine the college major, continue building the student profile, and update the roadmap.



5

Fifth Consultation • End of 11th Grade 1 Hr

Finalize the SAT/ACT strategy, strengthen the student profile, initiate the recommendation process, and provide an updated roadmap.

6

Sixth Consultation • Start of Senior Year 2 Hrs

Finalize student profile & college major, begin college selection, start application essays, and create a comprehensive application plan.

7

Seventh Consultation • October Senior Year 2 Hrs

Finalize the college list, complete application essays, and ensure all deadlines, documents, and submissions are tracked. Provide the final roadmap.

8

Eighth Consultation • December Senior Year 1 Hr

Review completed applications, plan for scholarships and interviews, and prepare FAFSA requirements.

9

Ninth Consultation • March Senior Year 1 Hr

Evaluate college acceptances, compare financial aid offers, and finalize the college decision.
